Support Staff & Family: Please help adult consumers apply!

You may receive the Renter Assistance Reimbursement If you-

1. Are an adult with a disability **OR** are a senior (62 and up)
 2. Are a U.S. citizen or have a qualifying alien status
 3. Paid rent of \$50 or more a month in California for your apartment, condo, house, room, or Adult Residential Group Home (**NOT** Intermediate Care Facility- ICF)
 4. Were a California renter on 12/31/07, but only rented part of the year, you may receive a partial payment
 5. Made less than **\$44,096** in total income in 2007 (SSI, SSA, SSDI, work, interest...)
 6. **Fill out and send the Renter Assistance Claim Form 9000R by 10/15/08**
- ❖ If you received SSI, SSDI and/or SSA and don't work, you may receive the highest amount- **\$347.50**
 - ❖ If you worked and received SSI, SSDI and/or SSA, you may receive a smaller amount
 - ❖ Married couples- only 1 of you may apply

The 9000R form is automatically sent if you applied last year unless you moved.
